ORDINANCE NO. 2017-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 35 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON A PORTION OF 478TH AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL §32-25-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by its highway superintendent that a bridge crossing the Big Sioux River on 478th Avenue and located between 224th Street and 225th Street is in poor structural condition, and in order to slow the rate of deterioration, a reduced speed limit on this section of the road is necessary for the safety of its citizens.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that a speed limit of 35 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of 478th Avenue between 224th Street and 225th Street in Moody County, South Dakota.
