

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 25 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON A PORTION OF 470TH AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL §32-25-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received a request from the City of Colman, Moody County, South Dakota, to reduce the speed on a portion of 470th Avenue which runs through the municipal corporate limits of City due to the heavy volume of traffic coming into the City and to promote the safety of the citizens residing therein, and that the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it would be in the general welfare, benefit, and safety of our citizens so to do.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that a speed limit of 25 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of 470th Avenue extending southward from South Dakota Highway 34 and continuing to the municipal corporate limits of the City of Colman, Moody County, South Dakota.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that this ordinance is declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety in accordance with the provisions of SDCL 7-18A-8.

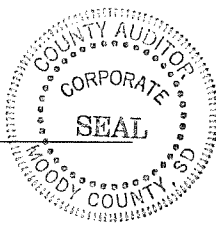
