

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING THE RIGHT-OF-WAY
FOR ALL ROADS IN THE MOODY COUNTY HIGHWAY SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL Chapter 31-12, there is established within Moody County, South Dakota, a network of public roadways for which the construction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of the same is under the supervision of the county superintendent of highways, and that is identified collectively as the Moody County Highway System; and

WHEREAS, SDCL §31-3-1 and SDCL §31-3-18 establish the width of public highways in South Dakota as being not less than sixty-six feet wide, unless such road is less than one-half mile in length and not located on any section line; and

WHEREAS, the Moody County Commission desires to establish a standard minimum width for all roads within the Moody County Highway System.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY MOODY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that all roads within the Moody County Highway System shall be not less than sixty-six feet wide, taken equally from each side of the roadbed center line.
