

UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF
April 7, 2026

The Moody County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, April 7, 2026 in the Farmers Room of the Courthouse at 9:00 AM, with the following members present: Jerry Doyle, Dave Reker, Kendra Eng, and Doug Entringer, with Tawny Heinemann, Auditor as Clerk of the Board. Also present Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant, Paul Lewis, States Attorney, Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator, Andy Muller, Highway Superintendent and the following members of the public: Lora Zwart, Garnet Paulsen, Brad Bjerke, Marlin Schrecengost, and Katti Geraets.

Chair Doyle called the meeting to order. Motion by Eng, seconded by Entringer to approve the agenda. All present voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to approve the following consent agenda with all present voting "aye":

Motion by Eng, seconded by Reker to conduct business as Board of Adjustments at 9:02 AM. All present voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Doyle to adjourn and resume regular session at 9:13 AM. All present voted "aye."

Andy Muller, Highway Superintendent met with the Board. Muller presented the bids that were received and opened at an advertised bid opening held in Minnehaha County on March 11, 2026 for the MC26-05 Southeast South Dakota County Striping Project. The following bids were received: Sir Lines-A-Lot with a total bid of \$89,630.00; and Vogel Traffic Services with a total bid of \$107,976.40. Motion by Reker, seconded by Eng to accept the low bid of \$89,630 from Sir-Lines-A-Lot and authorize Chair Doyle to sign the Striping Agreement. All present voted "aye". Muller notified the Board that he will be removing spring load limits on April 8, 2026. Muller expressed concerns about drain tile in the right-of-way. More discussion will take place at the April 21, 2026 meeting.

Tawny Heinemann, Auditor provided an update to the Board on the June 2, 2026 Primary Election, SB175, and Combined Election Agreements. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to authorize Chair Doyle to sign the Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the City of Colman at a 2.88% cost share. All present voted "aye". Motion by Eng, seconded by Reker to authorize Chair Doyle to sign the Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the Town of Trent at a 2.85% cost share. All present voted "aye". Motion by Entringer, seconded by Reker to authorize Chair Doyle to sign the Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the Town of Ward at a 2.06% cost share. All present voted "aye". Motion by Entringer, seconded by Reker to authorize Chair Doyle to sign the Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the Town of Egan at a 2.36% cost share. All present voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to authorize Chair Doyle to sign an amended Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the Oldham-Ramona-Rutland School District at a 2.88% cost share. All present voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to authorize Chair Doyle to sign an amended Combined Joint Agreement for Combined Election with the Brookings School District at a 4.94% cost share. All present voted "aye".

Troy Wellman, Sheriff presented a travel request to the Board. Motion by Eng, seconded by Reker to approve the travel request for Thomas Klein, Deputy Sheriff, to attend DRE training in Deadwood, South Dakota on May 6, 2026 through May 8, 2026. All present voted "aye".

Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization presented a travel request to the Board. Motion by Eng, seconded by Entringer to approve the travel request for Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization and Andrew Kompelien, Deputy Director of Equalization, to attend USPAP training in Pierre, South Dakota on May 3, 2026 through May 5, 2026. All present voted "aye".

Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to enter executive session at 9:58 AM pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2(1) for purposes of discussing a personnel matter. All present voted "aye". Chair Doyle adjourned executive session and regular session resumed at 10:19 AM.
