Chair Doyle called the meeting to order. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Entringer to approve the agenda. All voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Eng to conduct business as Board of Adjustment at 9:01 AM. All voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Hemmer to resume regular session at 9:28 AM. All voted "aye".

The Board met with Clare Township Board Officers, Dusty Schoeberl, Brad Klein, and Eugene Johnson to discuss the zoning violation on parcel 107.49.34.410 owned by Bernie Opland. Also present: Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator, Jodi Johansen, Clare Township Treasurer, Connie Beyer-LaLonde, Clare Township Clerk, Bernie Opland, and Kelly Opland. The violation remains unresolved as of today's meeting. Discussion was held on what needs to be resolved, and a follow up discussion will be held on June 4, 2026.

Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization presented a travel request to the Board. Motion by Reker, second by Eng to authorize Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization and Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator to attend the 2026 SDAAO Conference. All voted "aye".

Jerrick Charles, Emergency Manager met with the Board to discuss the current Burn Ban policy. Charles will seek feedback from the Flandreau, Trent and Colman Fire Chiefs at the next LEPC meeting on potential changes that may be needed.

Troy Wellman, Sheriff met with the Board to provide an update on the Dispatch contract with the City of Flandreau. Also present: Sergeant Klein, Moody County Sheriff's Office and Chief Arnold, FSST Law Enforcement. Sheriff Wellman advised the Board that the City of Flandreau is in the process of seeking information from other agencies to provide their dispatching and/or 911 service. Sheriff Wellman will provide an update once more information is available.

Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant met with the Board. An addendum to the lease with Interlakes Community Action was discussed. The Lease Addendum will be presented at the next meeting for approval. Skroch presented two liquor license requests. Motion by Eng, seconded by Reker to approve the Retail (on-off sale) Malt Beverage and SD Farm Wine License renewal for MAAC Ventures. All voted "aye". Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Entringer to approve and issue a Special Beer Permit to Flandreau Rodeo Association for the Casey Wilson Memorial Rodeo held on June 5, 2026 and June 6, 2026 at the rodeo grounds located at 600 S Veterans St in Flandreau. All voted "aye".

Tawny Heinemann, County Auditor met with the Board. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to approve the minutes from May 5, 2026. All voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Hemmer to approve the following resolution with all voting "aye":

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners designated operating transfers out of the General Fund to the Highway Fund, the 911 Fund and Civil Defense Fund for 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Operating Transfer out of the General Fund to the Highway fund for \$950,000; 911 fund for \$250,000; and Civil Defense \$75,000 be approved as outlined in the 2026 Annual Budget.
