Marty Skroch, Commission assistant provided an update on the zoning violation on parcel 107.49.34.410 owned by Bernie Opland. Also present: Clare Township Board Officers, Dusty Schoeberl, Brad Klein, Eugene Johnson, Jodi Johansen, and Connie Beyer-LaLonde. The violation remains unresolved as of today's meeting, but progress is being made. No action was taken and an update on the status will be provided at the June 16, 2026 meeting.

Tawny Heinemann, Auditor met with the Board and provided a recap of the June 2, 2026 Primary Election and turnout numbers. The Board conducted the Official Canvass of Votes for the Primary Election held on June 2, 2026. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to approve the Official Canvass as certified, and submit it to the Secretary of State. All present voted "aye". Random selection of the precinct and contests for the post-election audit pursuant to SDCL 12-17B-20 was completed. Precinct 3/4 will be audited with the Republican Governor and United States Representative races being manually counted. The Post Election Audit will be held on June 18th at 10:00 am in the Courtroom of the Courthouse.
