Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of the City of Flandreau, I am writing to request a joint meeting between the Moody County Commission and the Flandreau City Council to receive a presentation from Watertown 911 regarding emergency dispatch services and what a potential transition to their system would entail.

As both the County and City continue to evaluate the long-term needs and sustainability of emergency communications services, it is important that elected officials have the opportunity to hear directly from Watertown 911 representatives regarding their operational model, implementation process, service capabilities, costs, and the overall timeline associated with a transition. The presentation would be informational in nature and would provide both governing bodies with a shared understanding of the opportunities, challenges, and considerations involved in such a change. Given the regional importance of emergency communications and the impact any future decisions may have on both City and County residents, a joint meeting would allow for productive discussion and ensure all stakeholders receive the same information at the same time.

The City Council respectfully requests that the Moody County Commission consider scheduling a joint meeting at a date and time that is convenient for the County. City staff will work with County staff and representatives from Watertown 911 to coordinate availability and meeting logistics. Thank you for your consideration of this request. We appreciate the continued partnership between Moody County and the City of Flandreau and look forward to the opportunity to discuss this important matter together.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CLASSIFICATION OF MOODY COUNTY 911 TELECOMMUNICATORS AS CLASS B MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH DAKOTA RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, a 911 telecommunicator is defined in SDCL 34-45-22 as any employee of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, whose primary full-time or part-time duties are receiving, processing, and transmitting public safety information received through a 911 emergency reporting system as defined in SDCL 34-45-1; and

WHEREAS, the daily duties of a telecommunicator can be demanding, stressful, and emotionally exhausting; and

WHEREAS, low unemployment and labor challenges compel new strategies to retain these dedicated public servants; and

WHEREAS, it is the position of the The Moody County Commission to classify the counties 911

telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Moody County Commission strongly encourages the South Dakota Retirement System Board of Trustees to reclassify the counties 911 telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System.
