Chair Doyle called the meeting to order. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Reker to approve the agenda. All voted “aye”. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to approve the following consent agenda with all voting “aye”:

Minutes: May 22, 2026 June 4, 2026

The Board met with Clare Township Board Officers, Dusty Schoeberl, Brad Klein, and Eugene Johnson to discuss the zoning violation on parcel 107.49.34.410 owned by Bernie Opland. Also present: Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator, Jodi Johansen, Clare Township Treasurer, Connie Beyer-LaLonde, Clare Township Clerk, Bernie Opland, and Bonnie Pinnernd. The issues outlined in previous violation discussed have been addressed and resolved as of today’s meeting. The boards discussed a letter of assurance to keep the property in compliance and require future violations are resolved in a timely manner. States Attorney Lewis and Zoning Administrator Deschepper will take feedback on concerns discussed at today’s meeting and draft a letter of assurance to be reviewed and approved at the July 7, 2026 meeting.

Tyenna Muller, 4-H Program Assistant presented a staffing request. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Reker to hire Cody Williams, Seasonal 4-H Assistant, on a part time as needed basis up to 100 hours per year effective June 16, 2026, at \$20.00 per hour. All voted “aye”.

Troy Wellman, Sheriff met with the Board. Sheriff Wellman presented a hire request. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Eng to hire Tyler Wallert, Deputy Sheriff at Grade 21 Step E \$27.49 per hour effective June 29, 2026. All voted “aye”. Sheriff Wellman discussed a request from the City of Flandreau to have a joint meeting to hear a presentation from Watertown 911 representatives. The Board agreed that any presentation regarding a major change to dispatch should be heard by all of the stakeholders and should coincide with a Moody County LEPC meeting. Sheriff Wellman and Emergency Manager Jerrick Charles will coordinate with the LEPC Board to schedule a meeting.

Tawny Heinemann, Auditor discussed election staffing with the Board. No request was presented. Future discussion will take place if needed.

Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant met with the Board. Skroch presented a fireworks permit request for Pyrohaulic Fireworks. Motion by Eng, seconded by Entringer to approve a public display of fireworks for Pyrohaulic Fireworks for June 27, 2026 through June 28, 2026. All voted “aye”. Motion by Eng, seconded by Hemmer to approve the \$14,175 invoice from First District for the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan. All voted “aye”. The invoice will be fully reimbursed by the PDM grant. Skroch presented a liquor license renewal request. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Reker to approve the Retail (on-off sale) Malt Beverage and SD Farm Wine License renewal for Prairie Junction. **A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CLASSIFICATION OF MOODY COUNTY 911
TELECOMMUNICATORS AS CLASS B MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH DAKOTA
RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, a 911 telecommunicator is defined in SDCL 34-45-22 as any employee of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, whose primary full-time or part-time duties are receiving, processing, and transmitting public safety information received through a 911 emergency reporting system as defined in SDCL 34-45-1; and

WHEREAS, the daily duties of a telecommunicator can be demanding, stressful, and emotionally exhausting; and

WHEREAS, low unemployment and labor challenges compel new strategies to retain these dedicated public servants; and

WHEREAS, it is the position of the Moody County Commission to classify the counties 911 telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Moody County Commission strongly encourages the South Dakota Retirement System Board of Trustees to reclassify the counties 911 telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System.
