July 7, 2026

The Moody County Commissioners met in the Farmers Room of the Courthouse in regular session on Tuesday, July 7, 2026 at 9:00 AM, with the following members present: Chair Jerry Doyle, Randy Hemmer, Doug Entringer, Kendra Eng, and Dave Reker, with Tawny Heinemann, Auditor as Clerk of the Board. Also present Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant, Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator, Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization and the following members of the public: Garnet Paulsen.

Chair Doyle called the meeting to order. Motion by Reker, seconded by Hemmer to approve the agenda. All voted "aye". Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to approve the following consent agenda with all voting "aye":

Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Reker to conduct business as the Joint Board of Planning and Commissioners at 9:01 AM. All voted "aye". Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to approve the minutes from June 4, 2026. All voted "aye". Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator reviewed a plat with the Board. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Eng to approve the following plat resolution with all voting "aye":

Alicia Deschepper, Zoning Administrator met with the Board to review the Letter of Assurance for a Zoning Violation on parcel 107.49.34.410, owned by Bernie Opland. Motion by Eng, seconded by Hemmer to approve and authorize Chair Doyle to sign Letter of Assurance between Bernie Opland, Clare Township and Moody County for operating an auto salvage yard located in the North 908' of the East 743' in the SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 107 North, Range 49 West of the 5th P.M., Moody County, South Dakota. All voted "aye".

Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization presented a travel request to the Board. Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to authorize Whitney Sams, Director of Equalization and Andrew Kompelien, Deputy Director of Equalization to attend 2026 Assessor School. All voted "aye".

Troy Wellman, Sheriff met with the Board. Sheriff Wellman provided an update on staffing. Motion by Reker, seconded by Entringer to accept the resignation of Tyler Wallert, Deputy Sheriff effective June 29, 2026. All voted "aye". Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Eng to hire Sean Kosters, Deputy Sheriff at Grade 21 Step C \$26.60 per hour effective July 27, 2026. All voted "aye". Sheriff Wellman notified the Board that the LEPC has scheduled a meeting on August 4, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Colman Fire Hall to discuss 911/dispatch services in Moody County. A notice will be sent to the newspaper so that any interested members of the public can attend. A quorum will be present at the meeting.

Jerrick Charles, Emergency Manager met with the Board. Motion by Hemmer, seconded by Entringer to authorize Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant, to sign the Pre Disaster Mitigation Grant Quarterly Report. All voted "aye".

Brittany Bennett, Register of Deeds provided an update on the completion of the counter replacement in the Register of Deeds office.

Marty Skroch, Commission Assistant presented a request for a refund to the Board. Motion by Entringer, seconded by Eng to issue a \$75.00 liquor license fee refund to Blue Jays for the Live at the Riverfront event, due to the event being cancelled. All voted "aye".

Tawny Heinemann, Auditor reviewed 2027 Budget requests with the Board. More discussion is scheduled for Tuesday, July 21, 2026. Approval of the Provisional Budget will be completed by August 4, 2026, with potential scheduling of a special meeting if needed. Heinemann presented the results of the Post Election Audit for the June 2, 2026 Primary Election. The Republican Governor and the United States Representative races in Precinct 3/4 were audited by a five-person board. After manually counting the races, the results of both races matched the election night tabulator count and County canvases with 100% accuracy.
